



***Evaluation Criteria for Brief Summary and Commentary on Selected Reading(s)***

Criteria		Points
No personal response is made to the issues/concepts raised in the text	Unsatisfactory	1-2 points
Analysis conveys little evidence of a personal response to the issues/concepts raised in the text. Student does not explain why the chapters are effective for them. The connections to their health are identified, but not explained or discussed.	Limited	3-4 points
Analysis conveys some evidence of a personal response to the issues/concepts raised in the text. The connections and implications to their own health, or the health of others is explained.	Satisfactory	5-6 points
Analysis conveys evidence of a personal response to the issues raised in the text. Student demonstrates that he/she is beginning to develop new ways of reflecting on their world. The connection to their own health, or the health of others is discussed, with risk and protective factors identified.	Above Average	7-8 points
Analysis conveys extensive evidence of a personal response to the issues raised in the text. Student demonstrates personal growth and a social/cultural or political awareness. The implications for their own health, the health of others is discussed, with potential individual and group actions identified.	Excellent	9-10 points
